## **A Message to Parents and Guardians**

Lloyd Preparatory School™ (LPS), operating as Lloyd Preparatory School of the Americas, is a private, independent micro-school that provides a restorative, structured, and personalized educational experience for every learner. From here forward, we'll simply say LPS — because once you're part of this community, you're part of the family.

Whether your child is joining us for a new beginning or entering our program after a difficult school experience, we want you to know this: LPS is a place for restoration, renewal, and growth. Some students come seeking a smaller, more personal environment; others arrive after challenges in traditional settings. Whatever the path, this moment is not the end of their story — it's the start of a stronger one.

At LPS, we don't see failure — we see opportunity. Our program helps students reset, refocus, and rebuild through structure, mentorship, and trust. We are not a traditional school day; we are a specialized micro-school where each student's schedule, environment, and curriculum are crafted around who they are, not confined by a bell schedule.

### **1. What Makes LPS Different**

LPS combines personalized instruction, restorative practice, and academic accountability. We prioritize structure and dignity over punishment, creating a calm environment that values reflection, confidence, and responsibility. Each day blends academics, mentorship, and life-skill formation — helping students rediscover purpose and self-control. Our staff builds personal relationships that remind each student: you matter, you belong, and you can do this.

#### **Limited Enrollment Model**

To preserve the integrity of our personalized, relationship-driven approach, Lloyd Preparatory School intentionally limits enrollment to a maximum of 30 students annually, with no more than 15 students onsite at any given time.

This structure ensures that every learner receives individualized attention, consistent mentorship, and a calm, focused academic environment. Enrollment is selective and based on program fit, not just availability.

## 2. Where and When We Meet

- **Onsite Instruction:** Two days per week at the Delray Beach Public Library (quiet, structured, respectful).
  - **Online Instruction:** Two days per week from home with digital assignments and teacher check-ins.
  - **Independent Coursework:** Select classes via Florida Virtual School (FLVS) — AP, foreign language, or credit recovery.
  - Each student’s weekly schedule is customized and reviewed with families before enrollment.

## 3. Individualized Learning: The SIP Plan

Every student begins with a **Student Improvement Plan (SIP)** tailored to their learning style, pace, and goals. Developed with the parent/guardian and school leadership, the SIP integrates academic targets, behavioral goals, and social-emotional growth. It aligns with existing IEP or 504 Plans and is reviewed weekly to ensure steady progress.

## 4. A Day at LPS

- **Morning Mentorship & Reflection:** Guided check-ins, journaling, or group discussion.
  - **Core Academics:** Focused instruction in reading, writing, math, science, and civics.
  - **Restorative & Life Skills:** Communication, responsibility, and decision-making practice.
  - **Creative & Independent Study:** Project-based learning and leadership development.

## 5. Safety, Structure & Respect

- No threats, no weapons, no substances.
- Accountability balanced with grace — every consequence includes conversation and reflection.

- Educators model calm authority and empathy.
- Partnerships with Palm Beach, Broward, and Miami-Dade Counties reinforce consistency and community alignment.

At LPS, safety isn't about control — it's about creating a space where students can breathe, think, and begin again.

## 6. Transportation

LPS does not provide transportation for onsite learning days. Families are responsible for drop-off and pick-up at the Delray Beach Public Library. We gladly assist families in exploring carpools or time-window coordination to make transportation manageable.

## 7. Educational Access & Intake Fee

LPS operates outside the state voucher system. Tuition varies based on each student's individualized plan, instructional needs, and level of support required.

<b><i>Standard Intake Fee</i></b>	\$175	Covers record review, SIP design, and intake meeting.
<b><i>Reduced Fee</i></b>	\$75	Available for families demonstrating financial hardship or qualifying for public assistance.
<b><i>Agency-Funded Fee</i></b>	<i>Variable</i>	Placement agencies may assume intake cost for referred students.

This one-time fee supports the individualized preparation each learner receives before their first day — ensuring that every student begins with structure, clarity, and a plan for success. Families requesting the reduced rate or waiver may do so confidentially during enrollment. Our goal is to begin your child's journey forward, not delay it.

## 8. Communication & Family Partnership

Parents receive regular progress updates, direct access to the Principal, and ongoing communication about academics and behavior. We believe trust is built through consistency, honesty, and care — not bureaucracy.

## 9. Next Steps for Enrollment

- ✓ **Initial Consultation & Fit Assessment**

A brief, structured conversation to determine alignment between student needs and the LPS model.

- ✓ **In-Person Intake Meeting**

Families meet with school leadership to review academic history, behavioral context, and student goals (IEP/504 documents encouraged).

- ✓ **Student Improvement Plan (SIP) Development**

A customized academic and behavioral roadmap is developed within 48 hours.

- ✓ **Enrollment Confirmation**

Families review tuition, finalize placement, and secure the student’s start date. Most students begin within one week. Because every student deserves a second chance — and a future worth believing in.

### Payment Schedule & Policy

- **Due Date:** Payments are due on the **1st of each month** and considered late after the **5th day**.
- **Late Fee:** A **\$25 late fee** applies to payments received after the 5th of the month.
- **Accepted Payment Methods:** ACH, check, Zelle, or cash payments are accepted. Returned payments incur a **\$35 administrative fee**.
- **Semester Enrollment:** Students enrolling for one semester only are required to pay the full semester tuition balance by the start of the term.

### Withdrawal & Refund Policy

- The **Application, Registration, Technology, and Administrative Fees** are non-refundable.
- Tuition is **non-refundable after the third week of the semester**. Withdrawals before that date are eligible for a prorated refund, minus fees.
- Families must provide written notice of withdrawal to the school administration.

---

### Re-Enrollment for Semester Students

Students wishing to continue into the next semester must complete re-enrollment forms and confirm placement **at least four weeks prior to the new term**. Enrollment is not automatically renewed.

### Additional Notes

- **Learning Materials:** Core learning materials and digital licenses are included. Optional print texts, lab kits, or specialized supplies may incur additional costs.

- **Scholarship Renewal:** Award recipients must maintain satisfactory academic progress and good behavioral standing to remain eligible.
- **Tuition Commitments:** Families selecting the 10-month plan are entering an annual tuition agreement, not a month-to-month enrollment.
